DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

We believe the Bible to be the inspired, infallible, authoritative, and inerrant Word of God. We believe in the necessity of salvation through the regenerating work of the Holy Spirit due to the sinfulness of humanity. We believe that salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone. (John 3:16–19; Romans 3:23; Ephesians 2:8–10; Titus 3:5)

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost—those who are saved to eternal life and those who are lost to eternal separation. (John 5:28–29)

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, who indwells and empowers believers to live godly lives. (Romans 8:13–14; Ephesians 5:18)

We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in Jesus Christ. (I Corinthians 12:12–13; Galatians 3:26–28)
